Because the Son of Man Is Coming

We used to enjoy reading stories about admirable watchtowers and the great heroes and heroines who stayed awake to guard our towns and dwellings against those who wished us harm. Today, however, we live in a world of advanced technology, and we seem to be losing the art of vigilance. Cameras, alarms, drones, and other devices now do the watching for us. They are indeed convenient, but little by little our natural ability to be attentive, an ability built into us by the Creator and once sharpened by living close to nature, is fading. I fear that we may lose essential qualities of what it means to be truly human. Humanity has fallen, yet each of us remains the best of God's creation, and so it is vital for us to preserve our authentic human identity.

As we begin a new Advent 2025, a season of waiting, renewal, and hope for the Second Coming of Christ, let us allow nothing and no one to replace the longing of our hearts for him. He wants us to wait for him, because having him in our heart, at the center of our life, everything in us will change for better. He will bring the whole kingdom of God into us, he comes with peace and eternal love, and so we can be totally renewed and revitalized. So, Jesus does not want this Christmas decorations to replace our personal longing for him. From the beginning he taught, "You too must stand ready, because the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect" (Matthew 24:37-44).

In summary, let us stay vigilant. Let us guard the lamp of our soul through an interior and exterior attentiveness to the presence of Christ. May we be ready when he comes for us so that we might sing 'Let us go rejoicing to the house of the Lord' (Ps 121).
